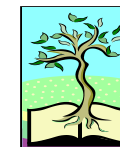


Cadishead Primary Homework Grid EYFS –School Closure

<h1>Have Fun, Stay Home, and Stay Safe !</h1>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Personal and Social Development</u></p> <p>Friday 8th May is the 75th anniversary of VE day, when people in the UK and Europe celebrated the end of World War 2.</p> <p>Can you think about any celebrations or parties you have in your family? What do you do? Do you eat special food? Do you go to special places, or visit people?</p> <p>Talk with your family about your favourite celebrations.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Understanding of the World</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Colourful capillary action</p> <p>Show how water moves up through plants using food colouring. This activity works particularly well (and quickly) with celery, but you could also use white-petalled flowers. Put some celery sticks (preferably with leafy tops) in separate glasses of water, then add different colours to each glass. Within an hour or two the celery will change colour as the dye moves up through capillary action.</p>

If you search you will find videos showing you how to draw other characters and animals too.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Physical Development</u></p> <p>How are you getting on with dressing and undressing yourself? Is there anything you need to practice? Can you get things on the right way round? Are you able to do zips and buttons?</p> <p>Try to learn to do something new all by yourself.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Helping at Home</u></p> <p>Make sure all the plants in your house and your garden are watered every day to help them grow.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>Make a sun safe poster (after you have watched the story of George). Don't forget to include the slip, slop, slap, sunglasses, shade- 'the 5 S's'.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Mathematics</u></p> <p>Draw around your foot and cut it out – you are going to use this to do some measuring. Place the foot at your starting point, eg, the edge of a table, and keep moving it and counting until you get to the other end? How many 'feet' long is it? Try to measure lots of different things around your house and garden. What is the longest/shortest thing you can measure?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>Subscribe to the Aphablocks page on YouTube.
